Vocabulary we will use with the children this week includes:

Literacy: capital letter, finger space, full stop.

Maths: What number comes after/before....? What pattern can you see? e.g. I can see 1 ten and 2 more (12) or I can see 1 ten and 6 more (16).

Understanding the World: Flower, leaf, fruit, rain, water, sun, dig. bean, root, seed, soil,

watering can, vegetable, plant, grow, pick, collect. Extend: pollen, harvest
