## **Sun Safety**

Please ensure that your child has a hat and a water bottle in school **at all times.**Unfortunately, if your child does not have a hat in school, they will be unable to play outside in the sunshine.

## **Toys**

Children are not to bring toys and other personal items into school. Much learning time is lost and there is often upset as we sort out ownership issues, look for lost items and try to repair breakages.

## **Watches**

If your child is learning to tell the time, they may wear a small, inexpensive analogue watch. No large digital watches please.

## Keeping everyone safe

Please may I remind you not to let your children ride cycles or scooters on the school site. There are cycle and scooter parks at both entrances.

#### Nuts

Please remember that we are a "nut and sesame free" school. Please **do not** bring nut/sesame or containing nut/sesame products into school.

## **Healthy School**

We are very proud of our 'Healthy Schools' status which is why we do not encourage children to give out treats on birthdays. We do celebrate with your child, playing our birthday cake shaped music box, singing happy birthday and giving out birthday stickers. The children love it and it makes them feel very special.

As part of our Healthy Schools program, we are a water only school which means making sure that water is the only drink in school. This means children are not drinking sugary drinks. Even juice that is labelled no added sugar contains natural sugar, which contribute to many preventable health conditions such as obesity and tooth decay. We can also then guarantee that no substances coming into school are harmful to children with health conditions and allergies.

I know that many children will not drink water at home, but will when in school encouraged by the grownups who support them.
